Manufacturer's Certification Statement  
**INDOW WINDOWS TAX CREDIT CERTIFICATION**

This Manufacturer's Certification Statement ("Statement"), dated August 1, 2013 identifies Indow Windows window inserts manufactured by R Value, Inc. dba Indow Windows ("Indow Windows") that may qualify as "Eligible Building Envelope Components" for a tax credit under Section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended by the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 (the "2012 Act").

The 2012 Act modifies the tax credit for certain energy efficient components that are purchased and installed from January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013. The tax law requires that certain requirement be met to qualify for the credit. For example, the components must be installed in a dwelling unit in the United States that is owned and used by the taxpayer as the taxpayer's principal residence. The original use of the components must commence with the taxpayer, and the components must be expected to remain in use for at least 5 years.

Indow Windows certifies that its window inserts are Eligible Building Envelope Components which qualify for a Federal Tax Credit allowed under Section 25C of IRS Notice 2006-26\*, credit for non-business energy property.
